

2. 3.	Fill the container about half full of water. Add a couple of drops of food colouring. Add oil to the container - you don't need to fill it to the top. Close the container with the lid - make sure it is sealed well! Shake the container as hard as you can, then set it down and take a look.

	 marbles or other solid objects
	hat to do:
	Fill your container about halfway with water.
2.	Carefully put a piece of masking tape on the container so it lines up with the top of the water. You need to be very careful and not bump the container so the water doesn't move.
3.	Slowly add about 10 marbles (or other solid objects) to your container.
