Segur Etug is an Australian aboriginal word meaning 'play'. This particular aboriginal game is a guessing game.

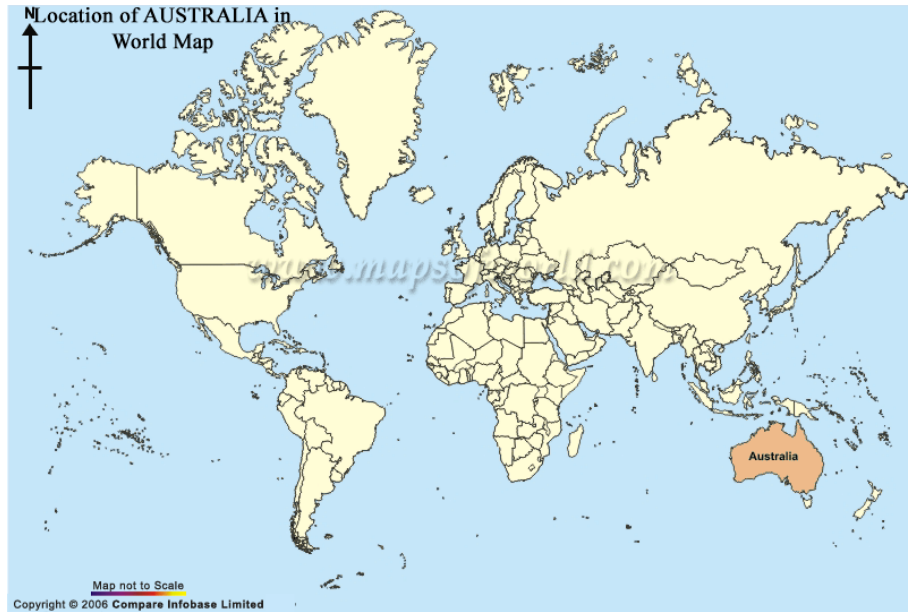
Age: All ages

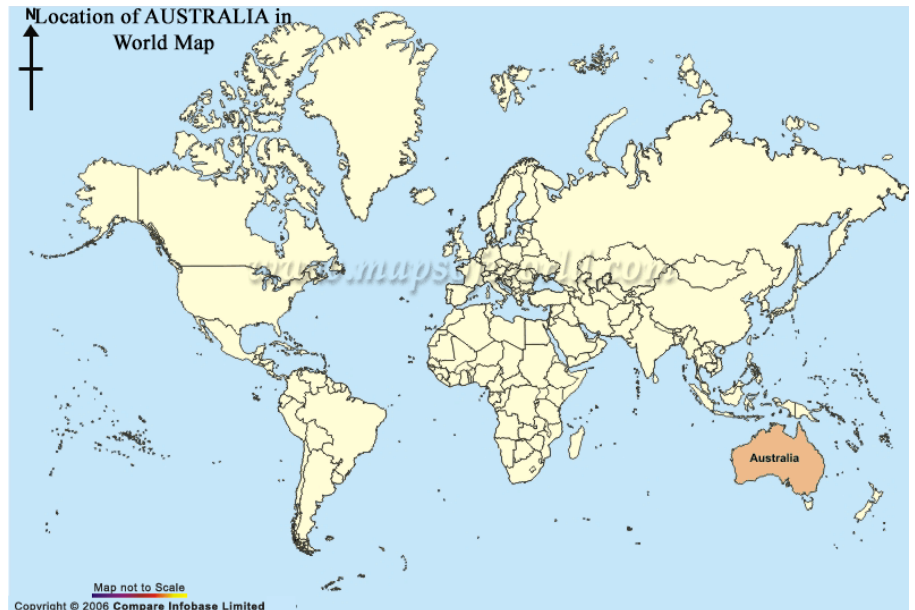
