Nice and warm, nice and warm.

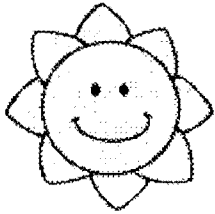


It is raining, it is raining,

On the windowpane.



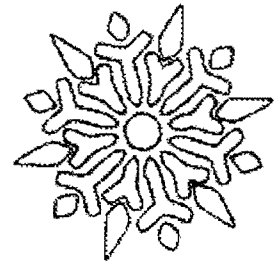
Seasons of the Year

(Sung to the tune of "Here We Go Round the Mulberry Bush")



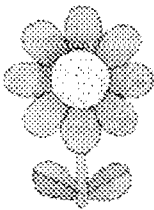
Here we go round the year again,

Because it is the spring.

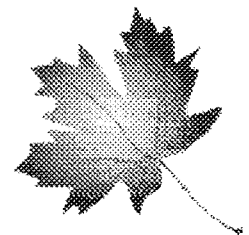
