



Let's Go Geocaching at Chichester Park

Note to leaders: This map is not for the girls to see, it is simply a guide for the leaders to know what their route will be. Make sure the girls stay on the path (except when finding Chi-Chi-Chichester), and help direct them on the shown route. When you are heading back to the meeting place, the compass will point through the water - instruct them that you are going to return to the path by going around the far end of the pond at the park (as shown).

Group 1 (yellow team): start at the end of Chichester Court, head west across the bridge then (at the yellow dot on the map) turn off of the main path and follow it to the end to find "Over the bridge and through the woods". You may take something from this cache. Once found, retrace your steps back to the dot, then head to the next cache.

Route Instructions

Group 1: "Over the Bridge and Through the Woods",
 "Chi-Chi-Chichester"
 "Sitting Pretty"
 "Suchi"
 return to meeting area.

Etiquette

- ☺ Take turns holding the GPS. We have four geocaches and one "meeting spot", so there are five opportunities to hold the GPS.
- ☺ When you find the geocache, do not touch it, but step away and tell your leader that you saw it. Don't tell the other girls in your group where it is. Let them look to find it. When everyone has had a chance to find the geocache on their own, you may move on to the next geocache.
- ☺ If you catch up to another group that is hunting for the same geocache that you have come to look for, hold back and wait until they are finished and have cleared the area before attempting to find it yourself. Don't watch where they are looking or hiding the cache.
- ☺ Don't tell any of the other groups where the geocaches are hidden - part of the fun is finding it yourself!
- ☺ STAY ON THE PATH - do not disturb the natural wetlands. The only time you need to leave the path is when you search for "Chi-Chi-Chichester".
- ☺ We will not be trading today. We do not need to open any of the geocaches except "Over the Bridge and Through the Woods" as that is a special geocache that we have hidden just for our Brownies. If you choose to open one of the geocaches to look inside, make sure that you hide it again exactly as you found it so the next people to come along will be able to find it, too.

Group 2 (orange team): start at the end of Chichester Court, go west across the bridge and follow the path until there is a side path that heads up over a small hill (orange dot). Follow that path to “Chi-Chi-Chichester”, which is a regular sized geocache listed on geocaching.com. Once found, retrace your steps to the orange dot, then go back to the bridge to take the path that group 1 took to the other cache in this area.

Group 2: “Chi-Chi-Chichester”,
 “Over the Bridge and Through the Woods”,
 “Suchi”,
 “Sitting Pretty”,
 return to meeting area. *Note: bring the “Sitting Pretty” cache container back with you.*

Etiquette

Before searching, make sure that group 4 has enough time to head over to their destination. Once found, follow the path between the two bodies of water to where group 4 was going.

“Over the Bridge and Through the Woods”,
“Chi-Chi-Chichester”,
return to meeting area.

Group 4 (red team): start at the end of Chichester Court, and head southeast along the path with group 3, past the bridge to the path that heads between the two bodies of water and to "Suchi", which is a micro geocache on geocaching.com. Once found, to avoid crossing the path of group 3, walk northeast around the water and back to "Sitting Pretty".

 "Sitting Pretty",
 "Chi-Chi-Chichester"
 "Over the Bridge and Through the Woods",
 return to meeting area. *Note: bring the Over the Bridge and Through the Woods" cache container back with you.*
